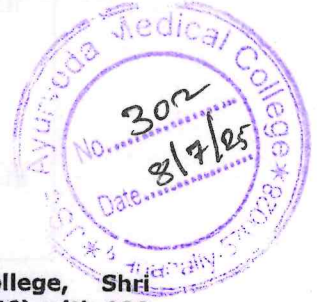

To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **JSS Ayurveda Medical College, Shri Shivarathreeswara Nagar, Mysore-570015, Karnataka (Inst. 2. Further, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of the enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, Assessment and Rating for Undergraduate and Postgraduate Ayurveda colleges and Attached Teaching Hospitals Regulations, 2024 and Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda Regulations 2024", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. **On careful examination of the assessment report it is found that your college is not fulfilling the notified & approved criteria, due to the following shortcoming:**
